Over the years, we have grown into more than just a festival; we have become a community, and more importantly, a family. Each year, we come together in these woods to share laughs, music, dancing, and love. We can't wait to make more memories with you. We love you, fam. Now, onto our values and principles!

PEACE, LOVE, UNITY & RESPECT

are not just words; they are the foundations of our rave scene. More than a catchphrase, they represent our goal of togetherness: being at PEACE with yourself and others, having LOVE for those around you and for what you do, fostering UNITY and communal awareness, and showing RESPECT for property and humanity:

The principles of the Big Dub community take the ideal of PLUR even further by adding essential elements: self-reliance, freedom of expression, and complete acceptance. These values and the passion behind them resonate deeply within the Big Dub family, which includes you.

We encourage both first-timers and Big Dub veterans to understand and embody these ideals, and we invite you to become part of Big Dub! Here are some of our core principles:

RADICAL SELF EXPRESSION: Feel free to be yourself. Wear what you like. Dance how you want. Talk to whoever you wish. You are free to share the gift of yourself

with others. Just remember to respect the rights and boundaries of those around you.

RADICAL SELF RELIANCE: Discover, organize, and depend on your own resources. It's fine to ask for help, but don't rely solely on others. If you do seek assistance, be sure to offer help in return!

PARTICIPATION: Nobody here is a spectator. We are all active participants in shaping this experience together, making it something great, and experiencing Big Dub from the front seat. Engage in an activity! Make a new friend! Listen to a set from an artist you've never heard before! The mountain is a canvas, and it's up to you to paint your experience.

LEAVE NO TRACE: We take pride in leaving Four Quarters in better condition than when we arrived. It's essential that everyone has the awareness to avoid littering, clean up after themselves, and respect both the venue and the Earth. Four Quarters holds deep significance for many, including ourselves. If you're unsure how to dispose of something, please ask a staff member for guidance!

GIFTING: This is the act of making someone's day by doing things for another without expecting compensation or anything in return. It can be a trinket, a conversation, or an experience. We encourage our patrons to give to each other in any way they can.

HEALTH & HAPPINESS

Just like Momma said, only you can keep you healthy.
What follows is the most important info in this program.

Health and Happiness Booklets are available at Registration, Information, and at Coffee Dragons. *Just Ask! Educate yourself!*

Whenever large groups of humans are gathered, there is always the possibility of being exposed to a bacteriological or viral infection. This is a particular issue in the festival circuit and with people traveling on the highway system. Being conscious of good food handling and camp hygiene habits will go a long way to keep these opportunistic infections at bay.

Norovirus infections can arrive through many vectors at any public event, and since Noro travels the highway systems, it is rare that there is just one point source.

Bacterial Gastroenteritis (The Hurling Squirts) is bacterial in origin and is almost always associated with poorly stored or prepared food. Onset of symptoms can be immediate and can last 1 to 5 days. Symptoms range from mild to extremely severe leading to hospitalization. The infected person is not themselves infectious to others.

Prevention:

- **Wash your hands – We Mean it!** Wash your hands like it's your job!
Hand washing is basically the only way to prevent Norovirus spread.
- Never casually share food that was not prepared and served by professionals in a serve-safe manner, or by persons personally known to you to be in good health and practicing active prevention. This will stop Gastroenteritis dead in it's tracks!
- Wash your hands after being in public and before eating. Do not hug people not known to you to be in good health. Never accept food offered to you by acquaintances.

REPORT symptoms to staff immediately if you or someone you know feels ill or displays symptoms. Symptomatic persons should immediately isolate.

Norovirus and Gastroenteritis are highly contagious; you can do everything right and still get sick, or do everything wrong and remain well. The single most important remedy for bacteriological or viral GI distress is education and communication. So keep sharing info and educate yourself! Wash your hands. Don't share food. Care for your body. Be well.

GENERAL INFO

The Stone Circle,
the beating heart at the center of Four Quarters.

GATE:

CARS: There is no parking available inside Main Camp. You can park your car only in the designated parking lot or car camping area. Please unload your vehicle quickly and return it to the main parking area in either New Camp, or Hilltop. A shuttle bus operates continuously from the afternoon until after the Stone Circle closes each night. Please note that **ABSOLUTELY NO CAMPING GEAR** is allowed on the shuttle.

TRASH: Your trash is your responsibility. Please be prepared with trash receptacles on your person so that you may take your trash back to your camp for disposal. ***Big Dub is a pack in and pack out event.*** All trash can be offloaded at the large dumpsters near parking in each camp.

Cleaning up is everyone's responsibility. As you may have noticed, **THE LAND IS SACRED**. It binds our community together. Let's care for it and teach others to do the same. Free trash bags are available at all staff locations. Remember to pocket your cigarette butts and wrappers, and put them in your camp trash bag. On Sunday, join neighboring camps for a col-

lective "sweep" to collect any stray trash. Then, give those bags a final ride (on your car hood) to the dumpsters on your way out. It's simple: **AVOID CREATING TRASH - BAG WHAT YOU DO - PICK UP LITTER - TAKE BAGS TO THE DUMPSTER**

MEDICAL: Our main EMS hub is located in Main Camp on the Seminar Stage across from Coffee Dragons and Camp Central. Our additional locations are at the **Big Bottom**, and in **New Camp**. Security can also be contacted at these locations.

DESIGNATED CAMPING AREAS: Camp only in designated camping areas. Use common sense and refer to the map for guidance. If you're unsure, please ask a staff member for assistance!

CONTRABAND: Big Dub Festival does not condone illegal activity. ***We bust people who sell.*** Please party responsibly and respect local, state, and federal laws. If you are unsure of our contraband list, you can ask a team member.

SWIMMING: Feel free to swim in the Hemlock Hole. But remember that it is wild, natural and dangerous. The Hemlock Hole is **SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK**. Please do not get out of the water on the far bank, and **NEVER, NEVER** jump into the water. To do so is cause for expulsion or risk serious injury. And please, no soap of any kind may be used in the creek. The beavers hate it.

THE COFFEE DRAGONS CAFÉ:

The Coffee Dragons is Camp Central for BIG DUB. Here you can find drinks, snacks, ice, an ATM Machine, and wonderful conversation with our staff!.

INFORMATION BOOTH:

The Information Booth is your one stop shop for all the info you'll ever need! They are located in **Camp Central near Coffee Dragons**. Feel free to ask them questions, give them compliments, or bring them gifts! You can find all activities and time slots listed here. You can also find event updates and shuttle information.

CAMP FIRES & GRILLS: Campfires ARE ONLY ALLOWED IN OFFICIAL FIRE PITS. Rings are free and first come, first serve. Firewood will be for sale and available at the Coffee Dragons Cafe and in New Camp. You are allowed to have camp stoves and BBQs in your campsite. Please exercise SERIOUS caution when using these items. Make sure you are not cooking around dry brush and grass, and be sure to NEVER leave your cooking tools unattended!! If you plan to grill, please have a fire extinguisher ready.

SHOWERS: Showers are available at the upper shower house near Coffee Dragons, and in North Crook. Shower tokens are available from the bill changers located in each bath house, or can be purchased from the **4Q Office** or **Coffee Dragons** by credit or debit card. Our showers run 4 minutes per token. Read the posted instructions and enjoy! Also, flush ONLY bodily wastes in the toilets!!!!

QUIET TIME: There is a Quiet Time from 5am - 11am each day.

No music will be played during this time and we encourage our patrons to respect their neighbors during these

times so that people can feel relaxed & be well rested.

BOUNDARIES & EXPECTATIONS:

Everyone is here to have their own experience. When interacting with others, make sure you are respecting their boundaries. Also, take responsibility for your own boundaries. If someone is making you feel uncomfortable, find a staff member! They will be able to contact security or EMS for assistance.

GENERATORS: If you are planning on using a generator, you must have a member of your camp attending to it at all times. Please make sure the pollution of your generator, both air and noise, is not going to bother your neighbors or disturb the land.

PUT IT IN A CUP: If you're old enough to drink booze, put it in a cup. Simple as that.

FIRE SPINNERS: Fire spinning is allowed on the Mountain. HOWEVER! You MUST exercise caution and take all proper safety precautions. YOU MUST have a safety and a safety blanket. Check out your surroundings!! If you are in an area with lots of dry grass or brush, it's NOT a good idea to light up. Be aware of sloping hills, hanging branches, and roots. We encourage you to spin at our Drum Circle, which is open nightly.

ONE WHEELS & BICYCLES: All patrons using a one wheel or bicycle MUST be wearing the appropriate safety gear. This includes pads, helmets, and anything else you may need! Please abide by 4Q speed signs, and be mindful of your surroundings.

PORTA-POTTIES: Close the Lid!

Let the *OH DEAR* go up the vent pipe. Don't dump trash in the porta-potties

SAFETY & SECURITY

OPIOIDS & FENTANYL:

Across the country kids are dying and festivals are being shut down as part of the Fentanyl / Opioid explosion. These incredibly powerful sedatives are now commonly used to adulterate almost all recreational drugs that are sold anonymously at festivals. Be Smart. Don't take a chance with unknown substances.

BIG DUB FESTIVAL does not condone illegal activity, and we track and bust people who sell. For your health and your fam's health, REPORT SELLERS TO SECURITY!

CAMP SERVICES:

are available at the Coffee Dragons, located in the heart of camp by the Upper Shower House. Coffee and firewood of course, but more importantly, information and communication.

Go To The Coffee Dragons To:

- **Get 10 to 1 chlorine spray for sanitizing surfaces and trash bags, both free for the asking.**

EMS / SECURITY:

The good people of Orleans and Flintstone Fire and Rescue are on site during BigDub, covering our community's back. They are highly trained volunteers and take time off from their jobs and family to be here. They are not paid anything for this work. Stop in, say Hi and show your appreciation!

EMS / Security hubs are plainly marked, staffed 24 hours a day and are located in the heart of Main Camp, and in the White Pines. Take the time to know their locations!

Go To EMS To:

- **REPORT ILLNESS**
- **Seek a First Responder or to seek First Aid.**

BACTERIAL GASTROENTERITIS

is commonly referred to as "food poisoning" and is a bacterial infection of the gut caused by ingesting colonies of bacteria; almost always from contaminated food, but some-times from surfaces.

It is not directly communicated from person to person.

Onset after ingestion is usually rapid, with symptoms that can include nausea, vomiting and sometimes diarrhea. In rare cases it can be life threatening.

Prevention involves the usual home cooking precautions of cleanliness, food storage and adequate cooking times.

Please know that the very safest foods are those prepared by a State Licensed Food Vendor or Licensed Commercial Kitchen; as are found here at Four Quarters.

SELF CARE:

Events at Four Quarters have busy schedules, and we encourage you to participate fully, but make sure you care for your needs as well!

Get adequate sleep (6 hours a night at least) and **stay hydrated** (drink water even if you are not thirsty). Remember, not taking care of yourself dramatically lowers your immune system and makes you susceptible to all kinds of nasties!

OUR DEEP WELL

was drilled in 2017 to commercial standards, over 400 feet deep with a steel casing liner to 60 feet, and a pressure grouted seal of the steel casing to native rock. The main water vein is

located at 350 feet, with water rising to within 160 feet of the surface of the well.

Unlike city water which is filtered from rivers, this deep water is incredibly pure. It is chlorinated and chlorine levels are checked daily. Monthly samples are drawn for testing and certified by PA DEP to the very highest standards..

All water spigots in camp are supplied from this well, and we are very, very proud of our water. Please never, ever wash anything, including your teeth or hands, at a drinking water spigot. Leave it clean for your fellow campers. ENJOY!

SIDELING HILL CREEK

is a Federally Protected Exceptional Value Stream, one of the cleanest in Pennsylvania. Feel free to enjoy its waters and swim in the Hemlock Hole. But remember that it is wild, natural and dangerous.

NO PROVISIONS FOR YOUR SAFETY HAVE BEEN TAKEN. YOU SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

And **NEVER, NEVER** jump into the water, to do so is cause for expulsion. No soap of any kind should be used in the creek, and of course... **DO NOT DUMP WASTE-WATER IN THE CREEK.**

ABOUT FOUR QUARTERS INTERFAITH

Four Quarters is a Church, a Sanctuary and beautiful Land in the Allegheny foothills of south central Pennsylvania, located 100 miles west of Baltimore-Washington. The Land is an enclosed river valley, bisected by Sideling Hill Creek, a Pennsylvania protected 'Exceptional Value Stream.' The surrounding cliffs form a naturally secluded retreat that features a broad range of ecological habitats ranging from creek-side pools to dry cliff face, mature forest to hilltop meadow.

Four Quarters now owns over 200 acres of Land, largely free of debt and forever free of private ownership.

The beating heart of Sacred Place is The Circle of Standing Stones, a living Sanctuary, open to all. Our Stone Circle began in 1995 with an idea—and one solitary Standing Stone set upon a forested hilltop. Today, over 60 Standing Stones grace that hilltop, outlining almost two-thirds of the final 200-foot diameter circle. With rope and rollers, sweat and joy, we do it by hand, the old way. In Community. Stone by Stone.

Four Quarters is the creation of the many people who have come to the Land, sensed something special, and made the choice to serve and support it in their lives. Those who live here under vows of monastic poverty, and our Board of Directors, who serve without compensation. Our ceremonial and grounds volunteers who provide so much energy to so many. Our Members and guests with their gifts of their presence, smiles, and money to support the mission. It is this Community of people in connection with each other and the Land that forms the magic that is Four Quarters.

We honor the many world traditions that reflect an Earth Based Spirituality, we work to support those traditions and welcome their people.

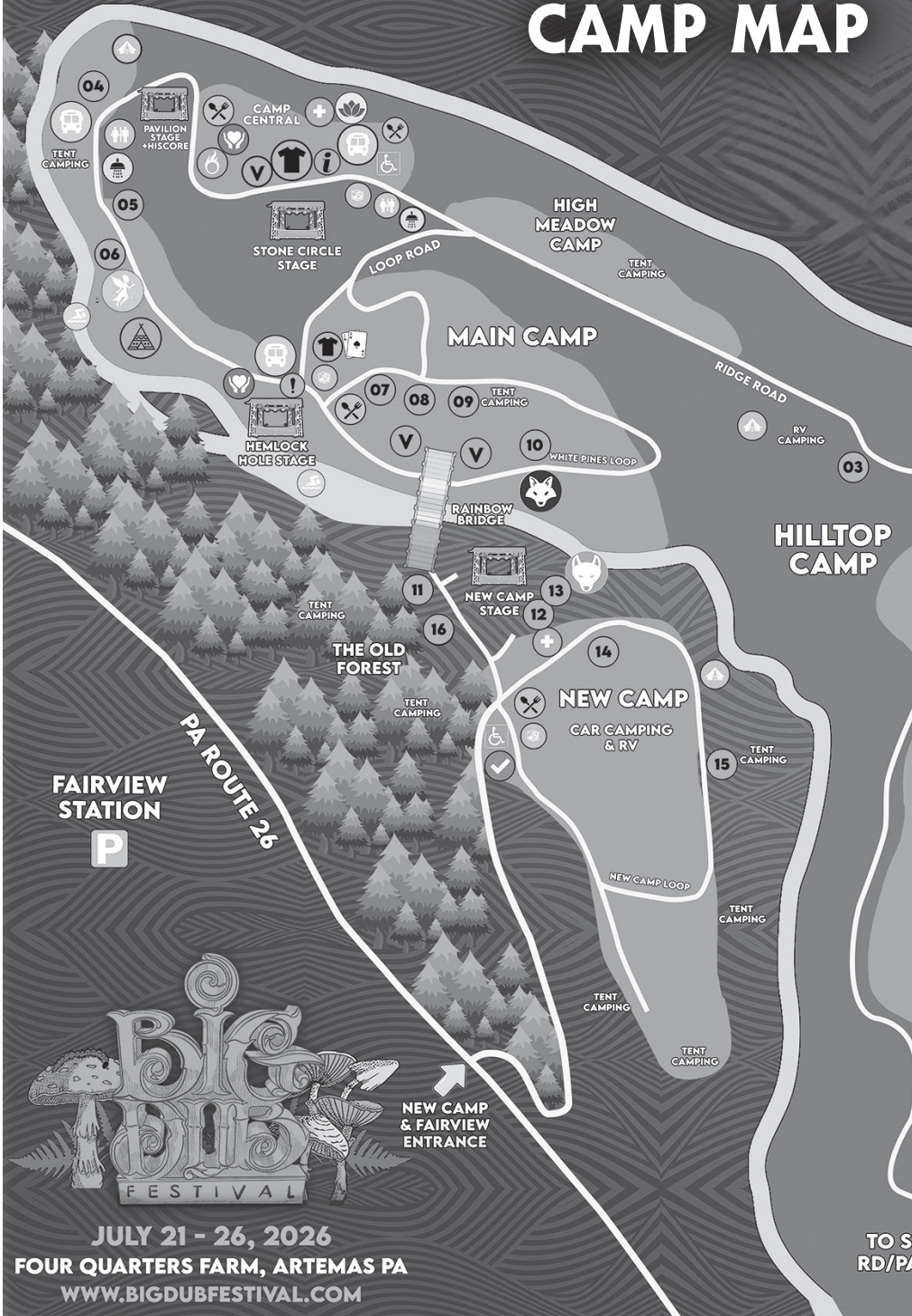

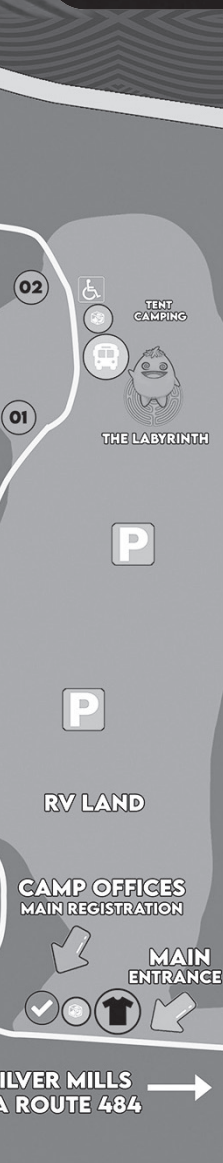

We're planning to run Ceremony at 3:00 PM Wednesday Afternoon and 2 Ceremonies daily on Thurs, Friday, & Saturday at 12:00 Noon & 3:00 PM. *All Start Times are approximate.*

The Sweat Lodge at Four Quarters is a beautiful and sacred site on the land at Four Quarters and we invite you to come to pray and sweat with us!

The sacred fires will be burning, you are welcome to come meditate, chill out, talk with us, and reconnect in our space.

The Sweat Lodge at Four Quarters holds to the same interfaith view as Four Quarters Interfaith Sanctuary and does not follow a single tradition or path. All are welcome. Our ceremonies facilitate personal and collective inner cleansing and healing. This is a ceremonial space and is to be respected as such.

A typical lodge has four rounds where the door is closed and water is poured on the heated stones, with brief breaks between rounds. It's good, but not required, to sit all four rounds. Ceremonies might last about an hour and a half to two hours. Bring a towel, drinking vessel, and whatever you want to wear, or not wear. ***Please hydrate yourselves!***

FOR YOUR SAFETY: No alcohol, substances, or other intoxicants in ceremony or in the ceremony area.

Please follow the guidance of Sweat Staff and the Ceremony Leaders at all times.

TALK, TALES & TEACHINGS

Visit Sweat Camp and hang with the crew. Storytelling, teachings, songs, good talk, and a safe place to chill. The Welcome Fire will burn into the night for guests to visit and hang.

Sweat Lodge ceremony at Four Quarters is provided based on the principle of ***Shared Risk, Shared Responsibility***. We expect people to act responsibly for the safety of all. All participants will be guided through our "Health and Happiness" hygiene policies and safety protocols. *Safety is our first and highest priority.*

Out of respect for the ceremonies and the teachings of our elders, we must respectfully insist that intoxicated persons must refrain from Sweat Lodge ceremony. Moontime (menstruating) Ladies, please speak to a ceremony leader for guidance, or with any questions.

Our deepest appreciation to our Sweat Lodge team for keeping the site, chopping wood, carrying water, hauling stones, and making our guests feel welcome and comfortable.
